PfP Summer Mountain Training Course Andermatt, Switzerland, 24th JUNE – 4th JULY 2025

The Armed Forces Mountain Center of Competence (AFMCC) in Andermatt offers a PfP Summer Mountain Training Course. On the first day of the course there is going to be an evaluation of everyone's skills. Depending on the levels needed there will be a division in different performance groups (basic and advanced)

All courses are free of charge, which includes the accommodation and meals on site at the barracks in Andermatt or in alpine huts, from arrival to departure. Please state special meal requirements on the application form.

Travel costs are to be covered by the sending Nation.

All course activities will be in uniform. Participants have to bring their own appropriate clothing (You need to bring your mountain boots).

However, unavailable clothing, equipment and technical material will be provided if needed.

Courses are open to NATO/PfP, MD, ICI and Contact States. Participants need to be active duty officers, NCO's or soldiers. No retired or civilian personnel will be accepted!

The goals are:

- Movement and survival in mountainous areas under difficult conditions;
- · Leading and guiding in difficult terrain.

Participants should be able to:

- move and survive in mountainous areas under difficult conditions;
 - Rope and Safety technology in rock and ice
 - o Orientation, assessment, tactics
 - improvised rescue
- evaluate any existing risks in mountainous terrain:
- · plan and conduct mountain tours;
- · fulfil missions in exercices in difficult terrain.
